\*Low-Speed crashes are when all vehicles are traveling between 1 and 10 mph and do not involve bicycles or pedestrians. Please Note: These crashes include: automobiles, vans, pick-up trucks, medium trucks, heavy trucks, semi-trucks, motor homes, buses, motorcycles, mopeds, trains, low speed vehicles, all-terrain vehicles and "others". These crashes include all types of crashes, for example, vehicles traveling at a low rate of speed but run into water and occupants are injured or killed; persons riding in the back of trucks or on vehicle hoods and falling off; semis hitting motorcycles, mopeds or ATVs are going to cause injuries even at a low speed.
